EMERGENCY DRILL AT THE SUNGAI DUA WATER TREATMENT PLANT ON 3RD NOVEMBER 2015

About 300 personnel from the Royal Malaysian Police, Fire and Rescue Department, Civil Defence Department, Health Services Department and PBAPP will take part in an emergency drill in the Sungai Dua Water Treatment Plant on Tuesday, 3rd November 2015.

The drill, scheduled from 7.45am to 12.30pm, will be witnessed by State Executive Councillor for Public Works, Utilities and Transportation, YB Lim Hock Seng, and Sungai Dua State Assemblyman YB Muhamad Yusof bin Mohd. Noor.

The public should not be alarmed by this simulated exercise. It is not a real emergency. It is a drill to evaluate emergency response to possible mishaps in the plant.

PBAPP will sustain continuous good water supply throughout Penang on 3rd November 2015. There will be no water supply interruption.

However, all participating government departments will deploy emergency response and service vehicles during the drill. As such, there may be some traffic congestion or diversions at a stretch of Jalan Lahar Yooi (P205), near the main entrance to the Sungai Dua Water Treatment Plant.
